

Mathias Nicolai¹⁵⁷, a priest from the diocese of Strängnäs, once violently attacked – without any bloodshed or major violation – a cleric from the same diocese and thus incurred excommunication, during which he officiated, and so incurred irregularity. The regent Franciscus, bishop-elect of Anagni, grants Mathias absolution from excommunication and dispensation from irregularity and disqualification.
